<u>Cabinet</u>: A group of advisors to the President, including heads of important departments in the executive branch.

<u>Checks and Balances</u>: In the Constitution, ways of limiting the powers of the 3 branches of government. It divides the powers so that no one branch becomes too powerful.

<u>Constitution</u>: The document that describes the government of the United States. It is the "Supreme Law of the land".

Executive Branch: The branch of government that carries out the laws.

<u>Judicial Branch</u>: The branch of government that interprets the laws and settles disagreements about them.

Legislative Branch: The branch of government that makes the laws.

<u>Veto</u>: To reject a bill and prevent it from becoming a law.

Congress: Made up of the Senate and House of Representatives.

<u>Supreme Court</u>: Head of the judicial branch and is made up of 9 judges who are appointed by the President.
