Tribes: Yakima, Nez Perce, Spokane

Artifact: • woven grass basket hat

★ Wood handled tool for digging roots - made from animal parts and wood
- needed to dig up cam root - important food

• Underground winter house - protection from cold
used grass-wood was scarce

Region: Northwest Coast

Tribes: Kwakiutl, Chinook, Tlingit

Artifact:

★ Waterproof, cedar bark rain cape:
used plentiful cedar bark for
protection against rain

• Cedar bark fish trap: made from
local cedar wood, used to
catch salmon

• Wood house with cedar totem
poles - made from cedar trees

Region: California Intermountain Region

Tribes: Pomo, Shoshone, Paiute, Miwok

Artifact:

★ clamshell necklace: made from clamshells
found along shore

• cone-shaped redwood houses - made from
redwood trees

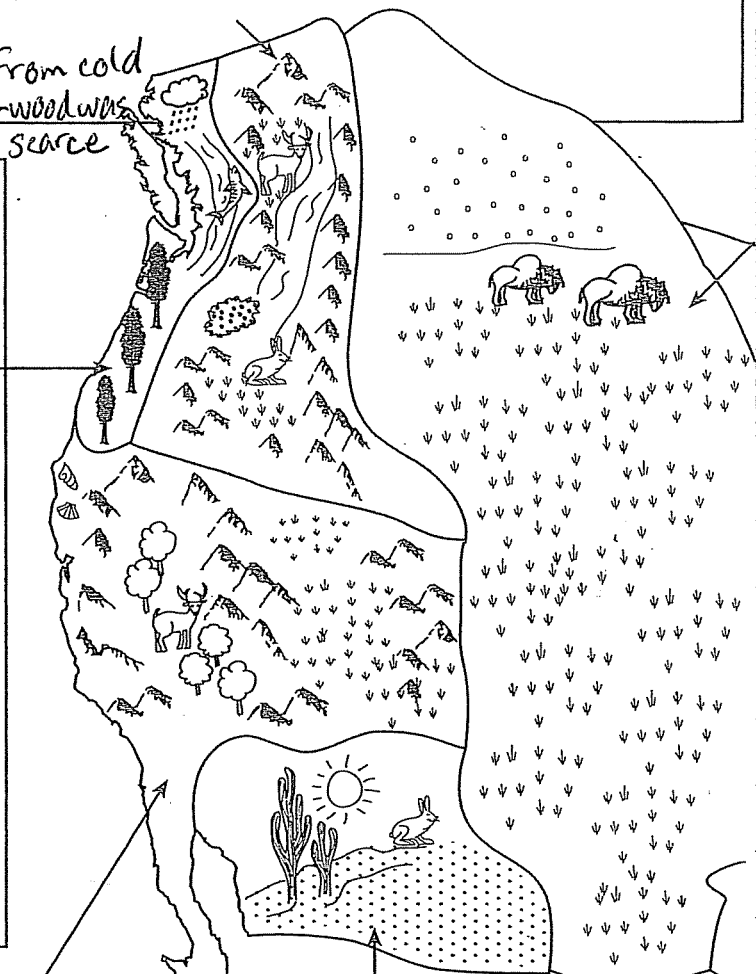
• Grass basket with beads, feathers, shells

Region: Southwest

Tribes: Hopi, Apache

Artifact:

★ clay pot - used for
storing water



Region: Great Plains

Tribes: Sioux, Pawnee, Comanche, Cheyenne

Artifact:

- ✱ Buffalo skin teepee - made from buffalo skin
- Buffalo hide blanket - from buffalo, protection against cold
- Buffalo hide shield - made from buffalo

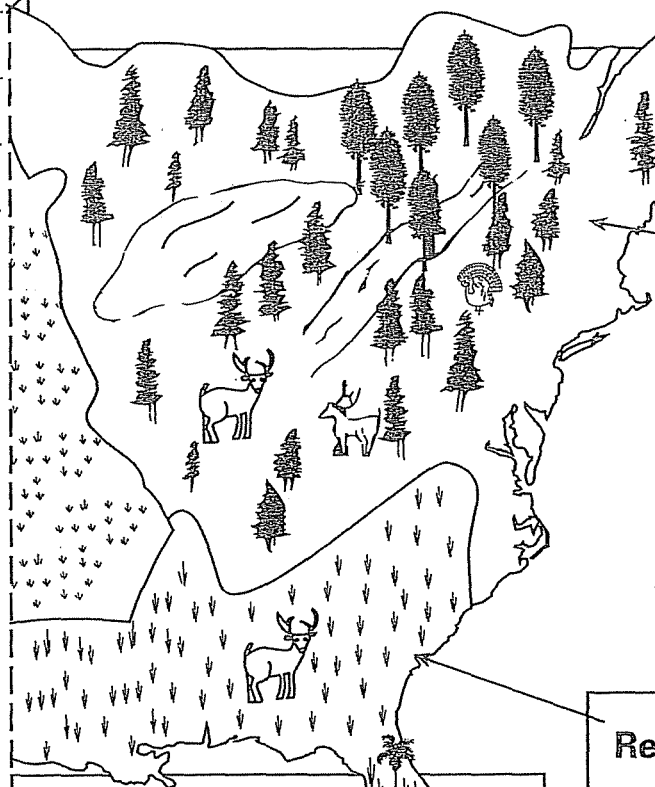
Eastern Woodlands

② Iroquois - Seneca
Mohawk



Artifacts:

- Turkey feathered ceremonial cape
- ✱ Birch-bark canoe - constructed from birch trees, light so it could easily be moved from stream to stream
- birch bark wigwam - made from birch trees.

Southwest cont.

- Adobe pueblo apartments - used clay because trees were scarce
- Cotton dress - good for cool or warm temps. local plants and minerals used for dye

Region: Southeast

Tribes: Seminole, Creek, Choctaw

Artifact:

- ✱ Palm leaf chickee - built on platform, protection from wet ground
- Cypress dugout canoe - flat bottomed, made it easier to travel in the swamp
- deerskin leggings - protection from mosquitoes and grass
