- A enslaved Africans people from Africa who were forced to give up their the freedom and spend their lives obeying and working for their "owners" or masters
- is forced to make a choice,

- Middle Passage The Voyage ("passage") of slave traders and enslaved Africans across the Atlantic Ocean from Africa to the Americas
- plantation a usually large area of privately owned land where crops were grown with the labor of workers or slaves who lived on the land.

Slave auction - A sale in which slaves

were sold to buyers who bid

for them. (slaves were usually

sold to highest bidder.)


A overseer - A person who was put in

slaves and could punish them


for disobeying him.
