British - Name given to the government and people of Great Britain; includes England, Scotland, and Wales.

Colonial Regions - Three large areas into which the 13 British colonies were divided.

Democratic - Government in which the power lies with the people.

Economy - The way in which an area's goods and services are produced, bought and sold.

Indentured Servants - Individuals who agreed to work for a period of time in exchange for free passage from Europe.

Plantations - Large farms that grew crops such as rice and tobacco.

Indigo - A plant used to make blue dye.

Assembly - A group of government officials who meet to make laws.

Diverse - Different from each other.

Dutch - People that came from the Netherlands also called Holland

Debtors - People who owe money.

Grant - To give to someone something that he or she has asked
