- * 6.1 Early English settlements
 - English sail across the Atlantic to make settlements
 - *settlements small communities
- 3 Groups came from England
 - 1) Roanoke
 - Lost colony
 - Island off of North Carolina
 - 1st English Settlement
 - 2) Jamestown
 - 1st successful settlement
 - Hoped for gold and riches
 - Present day Virginia
 - 3) Plymouth
 - Settled for religious reasons
 - Pilgrims people who settled in Plymouth
 - Present day Massachusetts

* 6.2 The Lost settlement of Roanoke

- Sir Walter Raleigh of England
 - Sent ships to America
 - Sailors landed on island
 - Roanoke after the Indians that lived there
- Indians would not give people of Roanoke food
 - o Indians fought with people
 - People returned to England
- New settlers were sent to Roanoke
 - Ran out of supplies
 - Sent John White back to England for supplies
 - ☐ Capt. John White could not return because England was at war with Spain
- Later Captain John White returned to island
 - Empty island
 - No settlers
 - CROATOAN written on gatepost of fort
 - Lost colony

* 6.3 Jamestown Colony

- King James gave permission to start colony in North America
- Settled along river in Virginia
- -named settlement after King James
- **Problem --> built settlement on marsh
 - Dirty water
 - Disease carrying mosquitoes

- Not good for farming
 - Most of the settlers died
 - Captain John Smith captured by Indians
 - o Powhatan ordered Smith to lay his head on rocks
 - Pocahontas saved John Smith
 - Indians started helping settlers
 - Hunt, plant crops, fish
- John Smith elected President of colony
 - o Colonists people who settle in colonies
 - o John Smith left and went back to England after being badly burned
- Jamestown grew tobacco
 - Could use to trade for money and supplies
 - "Virginia's Gold"
- House of Burgesses
 - Group of elected representatives
 - o More democratic government than England

*6.4 Settlement of Plymouth

- People looking for religious freedom
- People were first known as Separatists and later known as Pilgrims
- Sailed on ship Mayflower
- Before going ashore signed the Mayflower compact
 - Agreement about new government and how they would govern themselves
- Landed too late to plant crops
- Pilgrims were grateful to Squanto (Indian who helped them)
 - Plant crops
 - o Fish
 - Get syrup from maple trees
 - Squanto learned English from his trip to England
- Pilgrims had feast with the Indians
 - Thanksgiving
 - o William Bradford was elected governor for 30 years

****St. Augustine – oldest permanent settlement

**** New Amsterdam- A Dutch settlement that grew from the fur trade.
